- The content can relate to any routine veterinary nursing task. The content should be generic (i.e. not specific to your practice)
- State the Expected Learner Outcomes at the start of the video.  
(e.g. Discuss the importance of accuracy in this task,  
Show how to package items up for autoclaving,  
Demonstrate how to load the autoclave,  
Know how to check if the process has worked  
Know what to do if there is any problems with autoclaved materials)
- The video should be in MP4 format
- Animals should not be used in the video unless they will benefit from the procedure and you have permission from the owner.
- You may submit more than one video.
- Film in landscape (phone on its side)
- Ensure clear audio
- **The judge's decision is final. Correspondence will not be entered in to.**
